[This Final SEIS/EIR has been prepared by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers \(Corps\) and the Central Valley Flood Protection Board, the non-Federal sponsor, for the proposed construction of the approach channel of the Folsom Dam auxiliary spillway. The document supplements the Final EIS/EIR and Record of Decision completed in 2007 for the Folsom Dam Safety and Flood Damage Reduction Project by providing new and additional information on the design and means to construct the auxiliary spillway approach channel which was not completely defined at the time of publication. The 2007 EIS/EIR stated that the design of the approach channel would be determined in the Corps' pre-construction, engineering, and design phase and, as needed, supplemental NEPA/CEQA documentation would be prepared. The Final SEIS/EIR evaluates the direct, indirect, and cumulative environmental effects of alternative plans for the approach channel. Mitigation measures are identified to avoid, minimize, and compensate for resource impacts. Most potential adverse effects would be either short term, or would be avoided or reduced using best management practices.
