## The Jews in Fascist Italy: A History

**Enigma Books** My aim was to explain in detail the facts surrounding Fascist anti-Semitism and the persecution of the Jews in Mussolini's Italy. Too many people in Italy and elsewhere underestimate or deny the tragic fate of European Jewry and anti-Semitism between the two world wars. A few short years ago anti-Semitism appeared defeated and reduced to a tiny group of fanatics. But now it seems to be regaining ground in its more political incarnation, probably the most dangerous one, because next to the religious, social and economic varieties it is the most insidious of all. The author occupies a central position among Italian historians specialized in modern Italy's political history. He broke new ground by first publishing this book in 1961 having obtained special permission to consult the files in the Archives of the Italian Jewish Communities concerning the Fascist regime's persecution of the Jews in Italy from 1938 to 1945. The book's release coincided with the trial of Adolf Eichmann in Jerusalem that brought the Holocaust to the attention of other historians and to the world public. The English translation of the final 1993 edition was supported by a grant from the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs. This paperback and electronic book edition is published in association with the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum.

# The Trilingual Literature of Polish Jews from Different Perspectives

## In Memory of I.L. Peretz

**Cambridge Scholars Publishing** Are the literary works of Polish Jews one unified literature in three languages: Yiddish, Hebrew and Polish, or is the literal corpus of each of these languages a separated literary and cultural phenomenon? Twenty-seven scholars from Europe, the United States, and Israel explore different aspects of the multilingual literature of Eastern European Jews, with a particular focus on the trilingual literature of Polish Jews until World War II. The work of the great Yiddish and Hebrew writer Isaac Leib Peretz (1852-1915) represents the center of the book, though it does not concentrate solely on Peretz's work, but, rather, discusses the oeuvre of other unique authors in the cultural space of Jews in Central and Eastern Europe generally, and in Poland particularly. The book looks at this issue from three aspects, namely the literal, cultural, and historical, and also examines the dialogue of Polish Jewish literature with other languages and cultures.

## Judaising Movements

### Studies in the Margins of Judaism in Modern Times

**Routledge** The history of Judaising movements has been largely ignored by historians of religion. This volume analyzes the interplay between colonialism, a Judaism not traditionally viewed as proselytising but which at certain points was struggling to heed the Prophets and become a light unto the Gentiles' and the attraction for many different peoples of the rooted historicity of Judaism and by the symbolic appropriation of Jewish suffering. This book will look at the role of colonialism in the development of Judaising movements throughout the world, including New Zealand, Japan, India, Burma and Africa. Particular attention will be paid to the Lemba tribe of Southern Africa. A remarkable parallel movement in 1930s Southern Italy will also be dealt with. The history of the converts of San Nicandro is seen in the context of currents of Jewish universalism, messianism and Zionism. Gender issues are also discussed here as the converted women assumed powers they had not hitherto enjoyed.

Traducida a unos 2200 idiomas y dialectos, actualmente es un superventas en términos absolutos: es el libro más vendido en el mundo. Es un hecho curioso el que hoy en día, mientras las Iglesias cristianas tradicionales parecen estar en regresión, la Biblia continúa leyéndose: esto nos lleva a pensar que esta obra contiene un germen de vida autónomo y un mensaje siempre actual, hoy y hace tres mil años. Cada vez son más quienes leen por su cuenta la Biblia, por una necesidad de enriquecimiento cultural o, más a menudo, de búsqueda existencial. Pero no todos logran salir airoso de la empresa, en parte debido a la amplitud de la obra, indudablemente imponente, y en parte porque se trata de un texto de lectura bastante difícil. Este libro le ayudará a no estancarse en las primeras dificultades. Aquí encontrará las informaciones básicas y un itinerario de lectura ágil que le permitirán entender el mensaje fundamental de la Biblia.
