Two explanations can be offered for the somewhat altered focus of this volume. An individual's policies or beliefs about the environment represent these patterns. Human judgments are based then upon one's interpretation of available information. They are probability statements about one's environment and how one reacts to it. This condition leads to the human judgment process being inherently limited. It is fundamentally a covert process.
