Estimates suggest that tens of thousands of eyewitnesses make identifications in criminal investigations each year. Identifying the Culprit makes the case that better data collection and research on eyewitness identification, new law enforcement training protocols, standardized procedures for administering line-ups, and improvements in the handling of eyewitness identification in court can increase the chances that accurate identifications are made.
