Conforming to the aim of the ECC, the exhibition features architecture presented in a

broad variety of artistic media. Since the more than 150 participating architects originate from very diverse cultures representing over 50 countries and are also of different age, the works are highlighted from unusual, very personal points of view. In addition the catalogue also shows the exhibition VENICE DESIGN 2016 which was hosted by the ECC in Palazzo Michiel.
