La psicología jurídica y forense se ha convertido en una disciplina con un elevado grado de especialización dentro de la psicología. En la actualidad, cuenta con un corpus conceptual y metodológico propio, albergando un gran número de campos teóricos y áreas de aplicación. Todos ellos tienen la apasionante y complicada tarea de abordar las relaciones del comportamiento humano dentro del contexto jurídico-legal. La presente obra se compone de dos volúmenes: el primero compila aquellos contenidos introductorios de la psicología jurídica que incluyen algunos conceptos básicos del derecho, así como contenidos de la psicología más relacionados con los procedimientos y métodos que el psicólogo especialista en esta área de conocimiento debe manejar; el segundo volumen contiene los contenidos dedicados a los principales campos de aplicación.
