POLITICAL RELATIONS IN THE LATE POSTCLASSIC NACO VALLEY

University Press of Colorado Little is known about how Late Postclassic populations in southeast Mesoamerica organized their political relations. *Networks of Power* fills gaps in the knowledge of this little-studied area, reconstructing the course of political history in the Naco Valley from the fourteenth through early sixteenth centuries.
