Most watchmakers of this generation, specifically in Europe and Switzerland, are directly employed by the watchmaking industry. They are required to finish a related degree from a technical school. After graduating, they undergo in-house training from the company where they are employed. The training and qualifications that you will need as a watchmaker depend on where you intend to work. For example, Rolex, which is a Swiss brand that produces high-end watches,

requires their horologists to finish modern training and get the necessary certificates from a number of known schools. They also require their watchmakers to become a member of the American Watchmakers-Clockmakers Institute. Due to the proliferation of fakes, majority of modern Swiss brands implement tight quality control. They do not sell watch parts even to the most credible independent horologists.
