Where do we find that history, or that story, clearly laid out for us as we study our New Testaments? The answer is, we don't! Piecing together the story of the early Church is much like putting together a puzzle. Understanding the timeline is critical. It's like finding the corner and edge pieces of a puzzle around which the rest of the puzzle all falls into place.
